Lee's Crossing Cyclones Swim Team

The 2014 swim team is organizing now. Open Registration will be held at the clubhouse on Monday April 7th from 4:30 to 7 pm. New participants, from 5 to 18 years of age (as of June 1st) are always welcome. The cost is just \$35 per swimmer for those living in the neighborhood and \$85 per swimmer for those outside of Lee's Crossing. New this year will be the "Whirlwinds", a group of swimmers that must be 5 years of age by November 30th. These swimmers will be allowed to practice with the team, but not compete at the meets. A maximum of 5 swimmers will be accepted into this group. They must be able to maintain themselves in the water without floatation devices. The cost of this group will be \$25 per swimmer.

The team suit is new this year. Swimmers are welcome to wear a previous design, but if you are new or need a replacement they will be available for sizing and purchase at registration.

After school practices will begin May 12th - weather permitting. Morning practices will begin Tuesday May 27th. Meets will be held on **MONDAY** evenings this year. We will have three home meets scheduled for June 2nd, 16th and 23rd.

Parent support is **required!** It takes many hands to run a swim team, so please be ready to lend yours.

Registration packets – including more information about practice times and meet schedules will be emailed out to last year's team. This information will also be available at registration.
