Lee's Crossing President's Message

Spring is in the air – I know because I can see and taste the pollen in the air!

A total of 243 votes were counted in the election for the LCHOA Board that was completed in February. Angela Ford was re-elected as your Treasurer for the next year and David Hettrich, Walt Walker and I were re-elected as Directors for two-year terms. The Board would like to express our thanks to David Burke for participating in the election process.

At the Board meeting on March 12, I was nominated for and approved as the President of the Association for the next year and David Hettrich was nominated and approved to take over the position of Secretary for the Association.

The Board has agreed to formalize our neighborhood's already strong association with A.L. Burruss Elementary by becoming an official Partner in Education. A committee will be established to coordinate volunteer opportunities. We look forward to contributing to the outstanding education our neighborhood school provides to our children.

The Board has also approved replacement of the "kiddie pool" with a mushroom type water feature. We believe the feature will enhance the pool aesthetics and provide a better opportunity for younger children to enjoy the pool area. We hope to have this feature ready before the pool opening.

The Board approved and is in the process of getting quotes to add permanent lighting at the pool to be used for swim meets and other special events.

Finally, speaking of swim meets, the summer Lee's Crossing Swim Team is in the planning stages. Our meets will be on Tuesdays this year, and we will have two home meets. Laura Fenton, Swim Team Coordinator, is trying to ensure that all Lee's Crossing residents' children are given the first priority for participation.
