### President's Letter

The results of the 2016 Board election have been certified...Melissa Drehs-Roper, Joe Fenton and Walt Walker were reelected as Directors for two-year terms, and Angela Ford was reelected as the Treasurer for a one-year term.

At the March board meeting Melissa was elected to serve as the Homes' Association President and Walk Walker was re-elected to serve as Secretary.

I had a letter from a neighbor this week telling me about a dog attack while they were walking in the neighborhood. I have had two similar experiences while walking my pet over the past few years. We are very fortunate to have a well-lit, walker friendly neighborhood where neighbors feel comfortable walking and taking out their dogs. Please keep your dogs on a short leash and be aware of other walkers and pets when you are out. While at the Zone 4 Police Department meeting Thursday evening at the high school, I asked Major Kekler how homeowners should respond in the event they meet an aggressive animal. He encouraged a call to 911 to report any incident. Also, please clean up after your pet.

Major Kekler is our new Zone 4 Police Commander and held a town hall meeting on Thursday evening at the high school. He was happy to report that crime in our area is down from the same period last year. We are fortunate to live in a safe area of the Atlanta Metro Area and we thank our police department for their ongoing efforts to be visible and respond quickly to reported incidents. Major Kekler made it clear that homeowners should feel comfortable calling 911 to report even minor incidents, thefts, etc. in the neighborhood. Sometimes they can quickly address an issue that may be minor at the time but can escalate if not reported. If you have not yet subscribed to Marietta Police Nixle application, I would encourage you to do so to get information about traffic and other public safety information.

# **Summary of Parking Provisions for Lee's Crossing**



#### **Ordinance Restrictions**

Cars on our streets may only be parked where the right wheels are alongside the curb (and the right wheels must be within 12 inches of the curb). Parking where the left wheels are against the curb (the car is facing traffic) is prohibited.

Cars may not be parked where any of the wheels are on non-hardened surfaces (No parking with some or all of the wheels on grass, pine straw, etc.).

Cars may not be parked on sidewalks (either fully or partially).

No cars may be parked on any lot except on surfaces treated and hardened to accommodate vehicles of up to 8,000 pounds (concrete, asphalt, pavers). Parking on unpaved areas is prohibited.

Cars may not be parked within any intersection or within 30 feet of the approach to any flashing signal or stop sign.

Except in an emergency, the streets cannot be used to repairs to vehicles (changing oil, etc. is prohibited in the street).

Parked vehicles that obstruct traffic, obstruct access to property, and / or create safety issues in the street may be removed by the City.

Vehicles may not be left on streets as a means of storage.

#### **Covenant and Community Standard Restrictions**

Vehicles may only be parked on paved driveways, paved pads, and / or garages.

Boats, trailers, and recreational vehicles may not be parked upon a lot outside of a garage, except for temporary cleaning and loading, and except that small utility trailers may be parked underneath decks in the rear of the home.


Trucks larger than a standard pickup truck and vehicles with commercial writings on the exterior are prohibited outside of a garage, except that commercial trucks and trailers may be parked upon a lot during normal business hours while servicing the home or lot.

Inoperative and / or stored vehicles may only be parked in garages.

Owners and invited guests may park at the common property while using the amenities. Parking overnight on the common property is prohibited without the written permission of the Board.
