
# WANT TO RENT THE CLUBHOUSE?

The city of Marietta's Sanitation and IT Departments have released a new citizen-friendly, free sanitation app called "Trash Talk," to better aid residents with their trash and recycling needs.

Residents wondering what is against the rules to place in the trash can use the app to enter items like glass, paint can or motor oil. The app will then tell users how and where to dispose of these items. It will also give directions to a specific facility that takes those items.

The app also has a push notification system that will inform users if there are any changes in normal service days due to inclement weather.

Download the app from the App Store via the iPhone system or the Google Play Store via an Android Operating Device and search for "Marietta Trash Talk." Once downloaded, users can enter their address and receive various levels of notifications depending upon their needs.
