## **New System for Pool Access to Help Easily Identify Lees Crossing residents and their guests**

We're off to a great start with the pool season, and hopefully the rain will begin to subside soon! As we have grown as a neighborhood, and have many more new faces, the Board has decided to make pool access a top priority this summer. Unfortunately, with that growth, we have attracted more interest in our pool from folks outside the neighborhood than we would like. To that end, we are instituting "Pool Passes" for each household to help easily ID Lees Crossing residents. These passes will be distributed starting 7/4/17. The details are as follows:

- Beginning on 7/8/17, residents must have pool passes with them to use the facilities.
- Normally only one pass per family is needed, and can be left on a cooler, pool bag, etc.
- When you are at the pool, please make sure this pass is visible for easy identification, or provide it if requested.
- All other pool rules are still in effect. As a reminder, children under the age of 10 may not be at the pool by themselves, and all guests must be accompanied by a resident with a pool pass.

Please do not allow your pass to be used by anyone other than a person living in your home. Entrance to the pool may be denied for those without a pass, and there will be a fee for a lost pass.

We will be installing a sign before 7/8/17 at the pool gate to remind residents of this policy.

You can pick up your pass at the pool between 7 p.m. and 9 p.m. on 7/6/17 and 7/7/17 and between 9:30 a.m. and noon on 7/8/17
