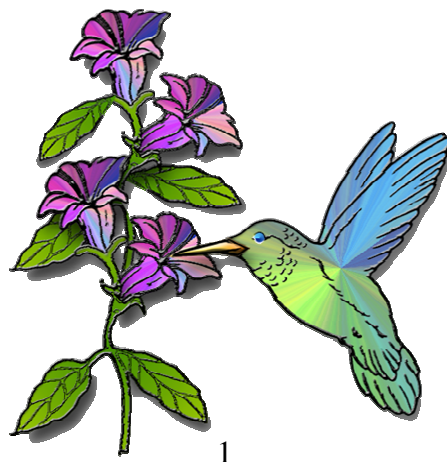
Congratulations to our neighborhood high school and college graduates and best wishes as you all move on to new opportunities.
