Lee's Crossing Cyclones Swim Team

Winter, will it ever end? Summer will eventually arrive, and with summer comes swimming. Registration for the 2014 Swim Team will be held at the Clubhouse on Monday, April 7th from 4:30 to 7 pm. New participants, from 5 to 18 years of age (as of June 1st), are always welcome. The cost is just \$35 per swimmer for those living in the neighborhood and \$85 per swimmer for those outside of Lee's Crossing.

New this year will be the "Whirlwinds", a group of swimmers that must be 5 years of age by November 30th. These swimmers will be allowed to practice with the team, but not compete at the meets. A maximum of 5 swimmers will be accepted into this group. They must be able to maintain themselves in the water without floatation devices. The cost of this group will be \$25 per swimmer.

The team suit will be new this year – swimmers are welcome to wear a previous design - if you are in need, suits will be available for purchase at registration.

After school practices will begin Monday, May 12th. Morning practices will begin Tuesday, May 27th. Based on the county's rotating schedule, our meets will be held on Monday evenings this year.

Parent support is **required!** It is mandatory for parents to work at least one full meet or two half meets. Many parents work much more, and their efforts are greatly appreciated!!

Registration packets – including more information about practice and meet schedules will be emailed out to last year's team. This information will also be available at registration. If you would like to join us please contact me for a packet or further information.
