## Potential Discount on Tree Trimming and/or Removal

Several neighbors have indicated they are interested in trying to get a bulk discount on tree trimming and/or tree removal. David Burke will be co-ordinating this effort. If you are interested in participating, please contact him at [david.burke@gmail.com](mailto:david.burke@gmail.com) by **March 5th**. Please note the following:

- We will be looking at both tree trimming and tree removal (as well as stump grinding)
- While we are working to get a group discount, all contracts will be between the homeowner and the tree service.
- You will need to be available for 2-3 companies to come and review your needs and to estimate the job. Payment to the tree service is your sole responsibility.
- Tree service is not cheap! You should anticipate, at a minimum, a few hundred dollars and up to several thousand for large projects.
- Please refer to the Architectural controls about what does and does not need prior HOA approval to be removed.

**National Drug Take Back Event April 30th**

On April 30th, 2016 from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. the Marietta Police Department and the Drug Enforcement Administration will give the public its 10th opportunity in five years to prevent pill abuse and theft by ridding their homes of potentially dangerous expired, unused, and unwanted prescription drugs. Please bring your pills for disposal to the Marietta Police Department at 240 Lemon St Marietta, Ga 30060. (The DEA cannot accept liquids or needles or sharps, only pills or patches.) The service is free and anonymous, no questions asked.
