Marietta - E-SPLOST is Coming



The March 21, 2017 ballot will include a referendum for an Education Special Purpose Local Option Sales Tax. A Special Purpose Local Option Sales Tax (SPLOST) for Education (E-SPLOST) is a countywide, one-cent (penny) tax on all consumer goods that must be approved by voters in a referendum and is in effect for five years. If approved, the E-SPLOST will replace the current E-SPLOST, take effect on January 1, 2019 and expire on December 31, 2023.
