Notice of Ron Lamb's Passing

Ron Lamb, a resident of Lee's Crossing for many years, passed away on the 25th of April due to complications from a stroke suffered approximately fourteen years ago. Ron, his wife Mary and their three daughters, Katie, Colleen and Rachael were some of the first residents of Lee's Crossing, living on Park Creek Court. Ron was a regular at the tennis courts, and he and Mary were active participants in Lee's Crossing social events. The girls' babysat throughout the neighborhood, and all served as lifeguards at the Lee's Crossing pool when they were older. Ron was religious as a runner and his devastating stroke at the age of 49, with three young daughters still at home, shocked the neighborhood. Residents of Lee's Crossing conducted the first *Run for Ron Race* in 2002 as a fundraiser for Ron's care. The race was successful beyond all expectations and provided great solace to both the Lamb family and the many residents who participated in one way or another. The race was conducted again in 2003 and 2004.

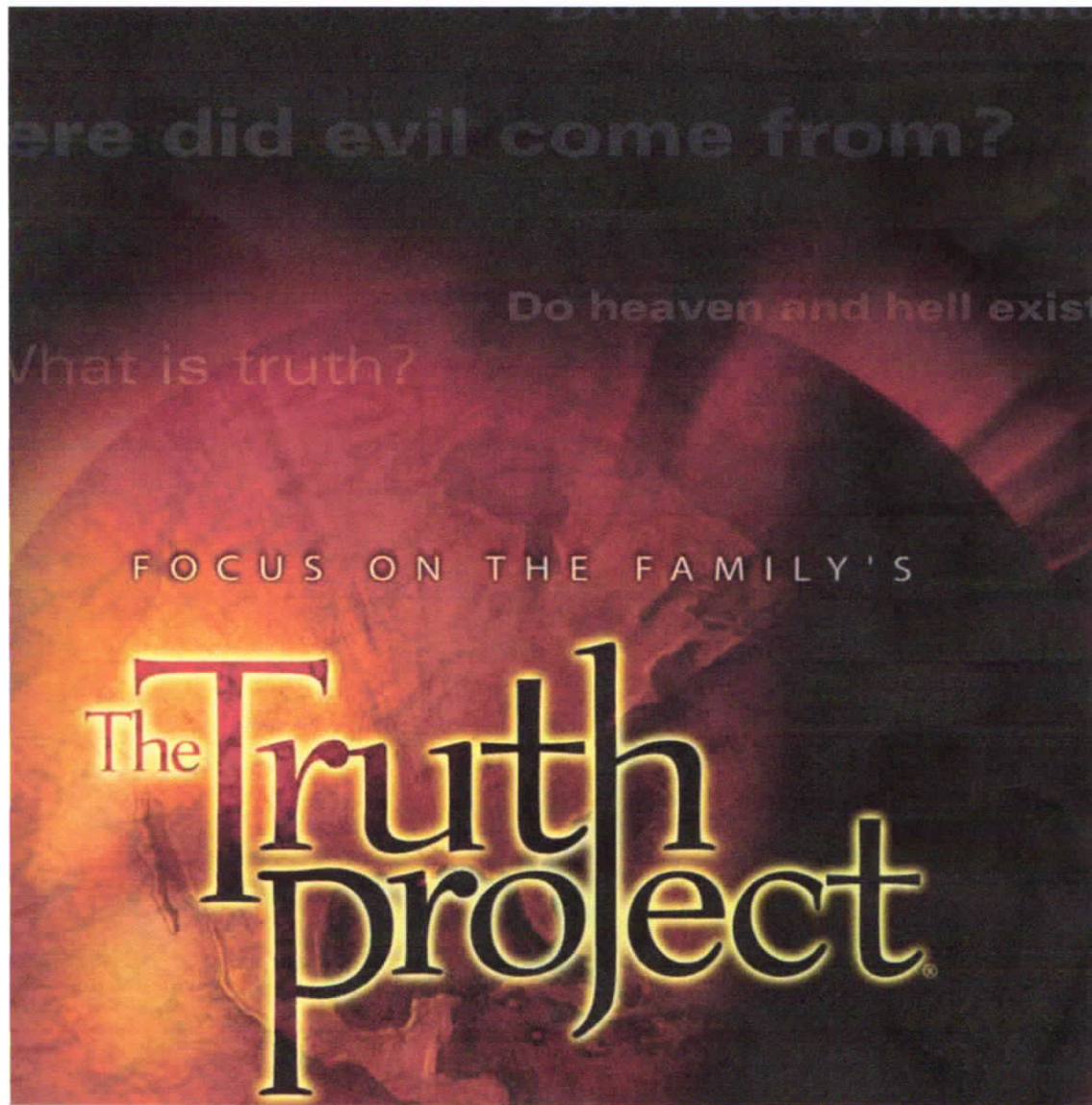
