## **Nominations for the Board of Directors**

The Board of Directors for the Lee's Crossing Homes Association consists of seven individuals elected by the members of the Association, six who serve staggered two-year terms and one who serves an annual term as Treasurer.

Next February, homeowners will elect three Directors for two-year terms and the Treasurer for a one-year term, with all terms beginning March 1, 2011.

Individual resident homeowners who are in good standing with the Association and who consent to serve as a Director or Treasurer may have their names submitted to the nominating committee for inclusion on the ballot. Nominees must be current on all assessments, must pay their 2011 assessments by the close of balloting on February 18, 2011 and must not be subject to any unsatisfied Association fines or liens.

The nominating committee consists of Erroll Eckford, Brad Herr and Jim Martin. Nominations must be in writing and must be received by the committee on or before November 30th. Nominations must be mailed to the attention of the nominating committee at P.O. Box 1013, Marietta, GA 30061.
