Thanks to all the neighbors who came out to join us at our evening at AL Burruss to talk about how we might help volunteer at the school. Katie Waters and Principal Julie King presented a list of ways that our neighborhood can assist the school. A wide range of volunteer opportunities has been identified, including helping in the Media Center, reading to students, helping students with math facts, painting bookcases, watering plants in the school, cleaning the aquarium, landscaping and outside maintenance, and lots of others things (as simple as collecting box tops for education). Several residents joined the Board at the September meeting to discuss issues regarding the pool. Most of the discussion revolved around providing more hours for pool use during the summer by opening the pool earlier in the day. The swim team uses the pool in the morning through most of June, so opening early is not considered an option during that time frame. The Board will consider the possibility of opening the pool earlier in the day after swim team is done. We were able to keep the pool open for some weekday hours after the start of school this season, but the ability to provide those hours in the late summer depends on our ability to secure a lifeguard, many of whom head to college or high school and are not available to work days after school starts. The Board is committed to continue to provide a quality level of facilities and access to those facilities for all the Lee's Crossing residents.
